#### From the desk of President

From the desk of President Dear Members,

It's been another year of glories and successes for the Association. It's my pleasure to present to you the Annual report and Accounts for the year 2013-14.

We commenced the year with the historic and memorable test match between India and West Indies which marked an end to the glorious career of Mr. Sachin Tendulkar. The test match was successfully hosted by the Association with the help of all the members. The test match will be remembered by the entire cricketing fraternity for years to come.

The Association has taken some major steps towards assisting the cricketers of yesteryears. The Association has decided to increase the pension amount to Rs.20,000/- per month from Rs.10,000/- per month for the umpires and players above the age of 70 years. Further the one time medical assistance is increased to Rs.50,000/- from Rs.25,000/- for the players and umpires those who are not covered by the BCCI scheme.

The Association also provided scholarships to deserving and needy junior cricketers under the Sharad Pawar Scholarship scheme.

Apart from the cricketing activities, the Association has also resolved the long pending issue of revision of rent of the tenants. It was decided to increase the rent of the tenants from Re.1 per sq.ft. per month to Rs.15 per sq.ft. per month. Further the tenants shall bear the actual property tax, water and electricity charges.

The Association has inaugurated the Sachin Tendulkar Gymkhana, Kandivali on 11th November 2013 and the facilities are appreciated by the members.

The Association continues to encourage the game in the suburban areas. With this aim the Association is continuously working towards developing new grounds in the suburbs.

#### IMPORTANT DECISIONS OF THE MANAGING COMMITTEE

- Times Group have agreed to bear the charges towards balls, umpire fees and ground charges for all the matches of Times Shield.
- ➤ It was decided to increase the pension amount to Rs.20,000/- per month from Rs.10,000/- per month for the umpires and players above the age of 70 years.

#### REPORT ON PLAYERS REGISTRATION

There have been some modifications in the registration of player's rules as follows:

- A player seeking registration should be a bonafide resident of the area under the jurisdiction of Mumbai Cricket Association, namely Mumbai and Thane Districts (extending upto Palghar and Dahanu in the western suburbs, Badlapur in the central suburbs and Navi Mumbai upto and including Kharghar).
- 2.) If the registration card or receipt is demanded by the opponent team, the player concerned must produce the same immediately after the close of the match. In case a player whose registration card is not produced on demand on the day of the match and he further fails to identify himself, the onus will be on the club to prove the bonafide of such player within 24 hours of completion of the game. If the player and or the club fail to produce the evidence such a player shall be treated as unregistered player. If this happens in the final match the club shall not be declared as Champion or Runners Up. If this happens in Dr. H. D. Kanga League, the player will be banned for 2 years and the team will be banned for 2 years and will play the league after two years in two division lower than they were playing.
- 3.) A player who is not a bonafide resident of the area under the jurisdiction of MCA and is eligible to play in a registered office tournament, by virtue of his employment in a company situated in the area under jurisdiction of MCA, in any office tournament, such player shall be granted temporary registration during the period of Tournament under these rules. Such temporary registered player shall not be eligible to participate in any of the registered club tournament on the basis of his temporary registration. The temporary registration will be valid for one season only, and should be renewed every season.
- 4.) It shall be the duty of the Club Secretary and the Captain of the team to verify that the registration of each of their players are valid and that the players are holding proper registration cards or temporary registration card issued by MCA, before the start of play.
- 5.) Any player found to be participating in any registered tournament without valid registration shall be debarred from playing in the said tournament for that season and for next season or as the case may be decided by the Registration of Players Committee. The Registration of Players Committee shall not punish any player unless the player is given opportunity of being heard. The Registration of Players Committee shall convey the decision in writing giving reasons for such action. If it is found in Dr. H. D. Kanga League, the club will be debarred for two years and will play the league after two years in two divisions lower than it was playing. The player will be debarred for two years and will not play further matches.
- 6.) Under-16 player is eligible to represent any division of Dr H D Kanga League 2014 provided that his plate League club has not qualified for Dr H D Kanga League 2014-15.

#### FROM THE DESK OF THE TREASURER

I take pleasure to present before you the audited financial reports comprising Balance Sheet as at 31st March 2014 and the income and expenditure for the year 2013-14 together with schedules and notes to accounts. The annual accounts for this year come to you almost within one year after presenting the audited accounts for the previous year.

The year had witnessed certain remarkable events briefly listed below,

- 1. The Association has restructured various local tournaments with effect from the Cricket season of 2013-14. Dr H. D. Kanga Elite and Plate League matches were played during the period from September 2013 to March 2014.
- 2. Prize and awards for the period from 2008 to 2013 were distributed during a function held in May 2013 after a gap of six years.
- 3. A test match was hosted between India and West Indies during November 2013 which was 200th Test Match of legendary Cricketer Shri. Sachin Tendulkar who retired from playing Cricket amidst a great gathering of VIPs and spectators.
- 4. The prestigious Sports and Recreation Centre at Mahavirnagar (Kandivali) was inaugurated on 3rd December 2013 which is named as Sachin Tendulkar Gymkhana.

As regards the financial position, salient features are as under:

The financial year 2013-14 has posted a deficit of Rs. 75.11 lacs after depreciation of Rs. 32.70 Cr. and reversal of income of Rs. 83.87 lacs booked earlier as monthly compensation receivable from Garware Club House due to pendency of an agreement between MCA and GCH.
The Association has earned net surplus of Rs.1.90 Cr. from hosting a Test Match between India and West Indies after providing for financial assistance, benevolent fund, maidan improvement and umpires benevolent fund.
The total expenditure incurred on Dr.H.D.Kanga Elite and Kanga League tournament was Rs.1.32 Cr. This was mainly due to increase in Ground Charges to Rs.3,000 per day, honorarium to Umpires Rs.1,200 per person per day and Rs. 750 per day to the Scorer.
The expenditure on administration has gone up by Rs.3.41 Cr. mainly on account of Employees Cost(including bonus/ex-gratia) gone up by Rs.1.13 Cr. pursuant to Wage Settlement with the Union, legal fees Rs.1.40 Cr. Function expenses Rs.0.62 Cr and electricity, telephone, travelling etc. Rs.0.16 Cr.
The depreciation for the year is lower by Rs.3.72 Cr. over the last year.
The financial assistance for F.Y.2012-13 and 2013-14 and Tournament & Kit Subsidy for F.Y.2013-14 due to the members is being remitted through RTGS/NEFT and cheques. These must have reached all the members in December 2014. Members are requested to provide/update details of bank

account if not done earlier for easy transfer of funds immediately to avoid any delay on the part of the

Let us have a look to the financial health in terms of assets and liabilities.

The salient features are briefly as under;

Association.



- The fixed assets after depreciation now stand at Rs. 281Cr
- The current assets are higher by Rs. 31.48 Cr. mainly due to increase in Fixed Deposits by Rs.23.50 Cr. Accrued Interest by Rs.1.59 Cr, Income Tax paid under protest Rs.12.73 Cr (and reduction by Rs.7.25 Cr. in BCCI a/c)
- The liabilities are less by Rs.6.28 Cr. which is due to appropriation of AC Box income against advance received.
- The net worth is finally higher by Rs.6.18 Cr and stood at Rs.265.43 Cr as on the end of March 2014.

As reported earlier, the pressure of payment of Income Tax demand continued in this year too. The Association was compelled to pay further amount of Rs.12.73 Cr despite having appeals pending at various levels. The total Income Tax demands till Assessment Year 2012-13 stood at Rs.74.27 Cr out of which Rs.17.24 have been paid.

I thank office bearers and members of the managing committee, the members of MCA, and staff members for their support and co-operation.

#### **AUDITORS' REPORT**

#### INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT TO THE MEMBERS OF MUMBAI CRICKET ASSOCIATION

#### **Report on the Financial Statements**

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of **MUMBAI CRICKET ASSOCIATION** ("the Association") which comprise the Balance Sheet as at 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2014, the Income and Expenditure Account for the year then ended, and a summary of the significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

#### Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements

The Association's Management is responsible for the preparation of these financial statements that give a true and fair view of the financial position and financial performance of the Association in accordance with the Accounting Standards and in accordance with the accounting principles generally accepted in India. This responsibility includes the design, implementation and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and presentation of the financial statements that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

#### **Auditors' Responsibility**

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. Those Standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and the disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the Association's preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the Association's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of the accounting policies used and the reasonableness of the accounting estimates made by the Management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our qualified audit opinion.

#### **Basis for Qualified Opinion**

- 1. Certain matters which were reported in our audit report of the previous year, and which continue to remain unresolved as at 31st March, 2014 are summarised as under:
  - a) Attention is invited to Note 5 of Schedule 20 to the financial statements, regarding a contract entered into with Shirke Infrastructure ('Contractor') to develop Indoor Cricket Academy ('ICA') and related facilities ('ICA Facilities'). The sums received under the contract as well as the capitalised amount of ICA and ICA Facilities are credited to corpus of the Association. The Association has taken a view that the same is eligible for income tax exemption and no provision for tax is required.
  - b) Attention is invited to Note 10(c) of Schedule 20 to the financial statements, regarding the non-provision of the tax, which is based on legal opinion obtained by the Association.
  - c) Attention is invited to Note 7 of Schedule 20 to the financial statements, regarding allotment of Airconditioned boxes. The Association has accounted for certain transactions on the basis of the Association's current understanding/ assessment/ available information in the absence of signed



contracts/ agreements/ confirmation from the counter parties/ all the required documentation, in respect of following matters:

- i. it has received amount of ₹8,000,000 in year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2011, from existing donors towards Air-conditioned boxes at Wankhede Stadium and accordingly the amount is added to the Building Fund.
- ii. the Association is of the view that there are no other indirect taxes applicable on the transactions.

In the absence of complete information, we are unable to form an opinion on the correctness/completeness/validity of the above income/expenditure/asset/liability recognised in the financial statements for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2014.

- 2. Attention is invited to Note 3 of Schedule 20 to the financial statements, as provided in the Settlement agreement, the Association has agreed to make available to Garware Club House ("GCH") additional Floor Space Index ("FSI") of 100,000 sq. ft. for additional constructions of GCH. The Settlement Agreement provides such new/additional construction shall vest with the Association. According to the information and explanations given to us, the construction of Phase I and II have been completed in the previous years and that of Phase III is in progress as on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2014. These transactions have not been recorded in the books of the Association. Till the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2013, the Association had recognised income from GCH "under protest". The Association, in the current year has decided not to recognise the income from GCH (net of TDS), till the time the settlement agreement is signed. Accordingly, the income aggregating to ₹8,138,880 has been reversed and ₹602,880 is recognized as income based on TDS certificate received in the current year. In the absence of information, we are unable to comment on the same.
- 3. Attention is invited to Note 5 (E) of Schedule 20 to the financial statements regarding amount of ₹70,000,000 received from Shirke Infrastructure. In the absence of necessary details, the amount has been accounted as Advance received in the current year. We are unable to comment on the accounting.

#### **Qualified Opinion**

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, except for the effects of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion paragraph above, the aforesaid financial statements give a true and fair view in conformity with the accounting principles generally accepted in India:

- (a) in the case of the Balance Sheet, of the state of affairs of the Association as at 31st March, 2014;
- (b) in the case of the Income and Expenditure Account, of the deficit of the Association for the year ended on that date.

#### **Emphasis of Matter**

Attention is invited to Note 6 of Schedule 20 to the financial statements, regarding the "Sports and Recreation Centre" Kandivali constructed by Shirke Recreation Enterprise which was handed over by the Association to Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai ('MCGM'). The cost of assets and construction of the facility have not been recognised in the books of Accounts.

Our opinion is not qualified in respect of this matter.

#### **SCHEDULE 20**

### NOTES FORMING PART OF ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31<sup>ST</sup> MARCH, 2014

 The MUMBAI CRICKET ASSOCIATION (the "Association") is registered under Societies Registration Act, 1860 and Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950 under Reg.No. Bom/300/74 GBBSD dated 21<sup>st</sup> October, 1974 and No. F 3451- (Mum) dated 30<sup>th</sup> November, 1974 respectively.

The Association is an affiliated unit and a permanent member of Board of Control for Cricket in India ("BCCI").

#### 2. Significant Accounting Policies:

#### A. Accounting Convention:

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention following the accrual concept of accounting in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles in India.

#### B. Revenue Recognition:

#### i. International match

Income from International Match represents revenue from sale of entry tickets (including entertainment tax), income from renting space for advertisement, rent from caterers for snacks stalls during match less expenses incurred for hosting such match, Financial Assistance to member clubs, contribution to Benevolent Fund, Umpires Benevolent Fund, Maidan Improvement and Development Fund under the rules and regulations framed by the Association from time to time.

#### ii. Domestic matches

Income from Domestic matches represents revenue from sale of entry tickets, sponsorship amounts and subsidy from BCCI less expense incurred for such matches.

#### iii. Match Telecast, Hosting Fees

The income from match telecast and hosting fees from BCCI is recognized in the year in which certain conditions as laid down by BCCI are fulfilled.

#### iv. Income from Property

Rental income from offices in North stand, compensation for the premises covered under catering services, Ground Hire charges, and Dressing Room hire charges is recognised on accrual basis except for the item referred to in note no. 3(c)

Income from lease rent of part of Cricket Centre is recognized equally over the contract period and appropriated out of Advance Lease Rent.



Income from use of facilities at BKC by BCCI as Specialist Batting Academy is recognised on yearly basis as per the terms of agreement.

#### v. Sponsorship Amount

This is recognized on the basis of terms of agreement between the Association and sponsor.

#### vi. Income from Air conditioned (AC) Boxes

Income from Air conditioned Boxes is recognized as per the terms of agreements with the allottees on pro-rata basis.

#### vii. Other Income

Registration, renewal and transfer charges from players, donations, and other miscellaneous income are recognized on receipt basis.

All items of income are recognized gross of income tax deducted at source wherever deducted.

#### C. Corpus (Trust fund)

Additions to Corpus including Entrance fees are accounted on receipt basis.

#### D. Transfers from Earmarked funds

The amounts transferred from the earmarked funds for incurring expenditure are shown to the credit of Income and Expenditure Account and the payments made against those funds are shown as 'Expenditure on the sport activities'.

#### E. Fixed Assets and Depreciation

Fixed Assets are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation. Depreciation is calculated as per written down value method at rates prescribed in the Income Tax Act, 1961.

The Leased Assets are amortized over their economic useful life.

The period of lease pertaining to plot of land on which Wankhede Stadium is constructed, expires in February 2018 and for which the management is confident of its renewal.

#### 3. Garware Club House:

- A) Compensation for additional construction from Garware Club House:
  - Monthly compensation receivable from Garware Club House ("GCH") towards the use of additional FSI of 100,000 sq.ft. as per settlement agreement dated 6<sup>th</sup> March 2005 is yet to be determined.
- (B) The Association is receiving ₹2,75,000 per month(as revised w.e.f. March 2010) as compensation charges from GCH under the Memorandum of Understanding ('MOU') entered on 6<sup>th</sup> March, 2005.



(C) In the current year, in the absence of agreement between GCH and MCA about compensation for additional FSI used by GCH, the Association has stopped recognizing the notional compensation mentioned by GCH as income on the said transaction. The unilateral amount of ₹81,38,880 as worked out by GCH since the year 2011-12 till 2012-13 has been de-recognized as Income (net of TDS) by MCA. The above amount is included as prior period item. During the year, the Association has recognized income of ₹6,02,880 based on TDS certificate received.

#### (D) Stand Reservation Charges:

As per the terms of earlier MOU signed with Garware Club House, status quo is maintained in respect of Stand Reservation charges of ₹1,20,00,000, collected prior to the existence of Garware Club House. The Association continues to appropriate annual amount of ₹3,00,000 to the Income and Expenditure Account over the lease period, which expires in February 2018.

#### 4. Cricket Centre:

As per the Deed of Lease executed between the Association and BCCI on 24<sup>th</sup> March 2007 for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor of Cricket Centre the amount of ₹7,98,64,000 received from BCCI has been credited to "Advance Lease Rent" which is being appropriated as "Income from Property" over the balance period of lease (₹72,60,360 during the year). The Association has constructed the Cricket Centre for a cost of ₹7,92,81,320 and is shown under fixed assets and depreciated over the lease period.

The Association has entered into lease agreement with BCCI on 10<sup>th</sup>April 2009 for 4<sup>th</sup> floor of Cricket Centre and the amount of ₹15,00,00,000 received from BCCI has been credited to 'Advance Lease Rent' which is being appropriated as 'Income from Property' over the balance period of lease (₹1,69,76,750 during the year).

#### 5. Indoor Cricket Academy and MCA Recreation Centre, Bandra-Kurla Complex

- (A) The Association had entered into a contract dated 12<sup>th</sup> December 2005, with Shirke Infrastructure to develop the site for Indoor Cricket Academy (the 'ICA') and the ICA facilities. For obtaining the right to develop the ICA and the ICA facilities, the developer would pay by way of negative grant ₹75,00,00,000 towards the Corpus of the Association over the contract period of 17 years and ₹5,00,00,000 as deposit for the maintenance of ICA, refundable only on completion of the contract period.
- (B) According to the terms of above agreement, the Association has received ₹60,00,00,000 towards negative grant till 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2014 which has been added to Trust Fund.

The interest income from the non-refundable deposit of ₹5,00,00,000 and the deposit are treated as Earmarked fund and is utilized for the maintenance of the Indoor Cricket Academy.

As per the agreement entered with Shirke Infrastructure, last installment of negative grant of ₹5,00,00,000 has been deposited in advance in joint account with the



Association with Karnataka Bank, Pune. The said fixed deposit in joint account has been reflected in the Balance Sheet of the Association under Current Assets, Advances and Deposits and corresponding contra entry of ₹5,00,00,000 has been made under Current Liabilities, Provisions and Loans.

- (C) During the year ended 31st March 2009, the Indoor Cricket Academy and the respective assets therein were capitalized for ₹18,80,03,000 based on the best estimate of M/s R. C. Jain & Co. Chartered Accountant and credited to Corpus. W.D.V. in books in respect of these items stood at ₹16,60,47,950 as at 31<sup>st</sup> March 2010. Subsequently, the Association got the valuation done from approved Government valuer who valued the same at ₹17,91,26,923 as at 7<sup>th</sup> August 2010. However, on a conservative basis the same are continued to be accounted as per the valuation adopted in the past.
- (D) The ICA facilities and respective assets therein are capitalized for ₹97,32,61,323 on the basis of valuation obtained from approved Government valuer as at 7<sup>th</sup> August, 2010 and credited to Corpus.
- (E) Pursuant to the "Supplementary Agreement" between Shirke Infrastructure and the Association, an amount aggregating to ₹7,00,00,000 received during the year from Shirke Infrastructure. This amount is accounted as "Advance received from Shirke Infrastructure". The Association has accounted for applicable indirect taxes, as recoverable from the party.

#### 6. Sports and Recreation Centre, Kandivali:

During the year, the Association has created the "Sports and Recreation Centre" at Kandivali as per the agreement entered into between the Association and Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai ("MCGM"). The Association started functioning the said activities on 'Caretaker basis', and its recreation facilities have been made available to its associates, cricketers, umpires etc. The assets and construction costs have not been recognised in the books of the Association.

7. The Association has entered into agreements with some companies/firms for allotment of AC boxes in the newly developed Wankhede Stadium for viewing the Cricket Matches over the period from 1<sup>st</sup> March 2011 to 28<sup>th</sup> February 2021.

The Association has received amount of ₹17,95,62,500 towards interest free deposits and recognized amount of ₹54,12,29,167 as income received in advance as at 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2014 from the allottees of AC boxes.

The Association has paid a sum towards Entertainment Tax as per the instructions received from the concerned Department of Maharashtra Government.

In view of the Association, there are no other indirect taxes leviable on the above transaction.



8. As per the terms of the concession agreement in regard to the 'MCA Recreation Centre', BKC, the Association has during the current year received associate fees amounting to ₹2,10,000. The same are credited to the Trust Fund. The associate fees received for 'MCA Recreation Centre', BKC in previous years aggregating to ₹86,70,000 is transferred from Income and Expenditure Account to Trust fund. Associate fees received during the current year in regard to the 'Sports and Recreation Centre', Kandivali amounting to ₹1,24,20,000 (Previous Year-Nil) have been credited to the Trust Fund.

#### 9. Group Gratuity Scheme with LIC:

The Association has a gratuity scheme for its staff with the Life Insurance Corporation of India ('LIC'). The premium paid to LIC is being recognized as expenditure in the Income and Expenditure Account. During the year amount of ₹4,69,155 has been paid to LIC.

#### 10. Tax and other Legal matters:

a. **Contribution payable to Public Trust Administration Fund** at Charity Commissioner's office:

During the year, the Association has provided ₹1,03,44,233 for the estimated contribution payable to the office of Charity Commissioner of Mumbai Region.

#### b. **Property Tax**:

The Association has made provision for property tax in respect of all properties based on the Property Tax bills received from MCGM. During the last year, MCGM has revised the basis of property tax bills from ratable value to Capital value which is disputed by the Association. The provision for outstanding liability aggregating to ₹10,70,87,148 as on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2014 has been made although the Association has disputed the same.

As regards refunds determined by Property Tax Department of MCGM for past period in case of some properties, the same will be recognized on receipt from MCGM.

#### c. Status of Income Tax liability:

1) The Association was registered as a Charitable Trust u/s 12A of the Income Tax Act, 1961 w.e.f 14<sup>th</sup> March, 1975. The Association's registration u/s 12A was withdrawn by the Tax Authorities vide order dated 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2010, allegedly with retrospective effect i.e. December 2005. The Association filed appeal before Income Tax Appellate Tribunal, Mumbai against the said order on 1<sup>st</sup> March, 2011. The matter was decided by Hon'ble Mumbai Tribunal vide its Order dated 8<sup>th</sup> August, 2012. As per the said order, the cancellation of Association's registration u/s 12A is held valid with effect from to 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2010, (and not with retrospective effect as done by lower authority). Both, the Income Tax Department and the Association have filed appeal against the said order of Income Tax Tribunal before Hon'ble Bombay High Court.

- (\*) For A.Y. 2009-10, there was refund due of ₹3,25,96,348. The Income Tax department has adjusted the said refund amounting to ₹3,25,96,348 (including interest on refund amounting ₹73,53,160) against the demand for AY 2006-07.
- 3) The IT return for A.Y. 2013-14 is yet to be filed as the Association's claim of exemption u/s11 is being rejected on technical ground by the Income Tax Dept.

Based on the Order of Hon'ble Tribunal Mumbai dated 8<sup>th</sup> August, 2012, the Association is of the view that, validity of its registration u/s 12A has been upheld by Hon'ble Tribunal upto 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2010. Consequently demands arising out of denial of exemption u/s 11 for want of registration u/s 12A of the Income Tax Act are illegal and liable to be quashed. Further based on the opinion of legal counsel, the Association is of the view that the Association would continue to enjoy exemption under Section 12A of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

#### d. Rent Income from Office Premises and Tenants' Matter:

On completion of redevelopment of Wankhede Stadium, tenants were handed over possession of their respective premises. Subsequently, the Association filed suits for eviction and fixing Standard Rent with Small Cause Court, Mumbai.

Pending the outcome of the legal cases, tenants are negotiating with the Association. Income will be recognized on the outcome of above matters.

#### e. **Selvel Matter**:

Association's claim against M/s Selvel towards loss due to Selvel backing out from tendered amount for advertisement during the test match played between India and West Indies in November 1994 was allowed by Honorable Bombay High Court. M/s. Selvel has deposited ₹43,22,922 in Canara Bank as ordered by the Court. The amount will be recognized as income after final outcome of the Appeal filed by M/s. Selvel.

#### 11. Contingent Liabilities:

- 1) <u>Income tax demands</u>:
  - As explained in Note no.10(C) above, total gross demands of ₹74,27,41,611 is treated as contingent liability.
- 2) The Association has been served with notices for initiating penalty proceedings under various provisions of Income Tax Act, 1961 amounting to ₹1,46,600, hence treated as contingent liability as the original demand is disputed.
- **12.** In the opinion of Management, the provisions are adequately made towards amounts due but not paid as on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2014.
- **13.** Figures of previous year have been re-grouped/reclassified to conform to current year's presentation.
